CP is NOT:

- contagious,
- hereditary, or
- life-threatening

Damage to the brain during pregnancy through age 3 may result in CP

I of every 500 babies and up to I in 3 premature babies are affected by CP to some extent

A term used to describe a group of disorders affecting muscle coordination and body movement

Covers a broad span of disability from a slight speech impediment (mild) to cases of virtually no muscle control (severe)

It's estimated that over 50,000 Canadians have CP
